EU Deforestation Regulation (EUDR)
Compliance

Dear Sir/Madam,

We would like to inform you about the EU Deforestation Regulation (EUDR), which entered into force on June 29, 2023.

This regulation aims to prevent deforestation and forest degradation by restricting the trade of certain raw materials and products linked to deforestation or illegal activities, including beef, soy, palm oil, wood, coffee, cocoa, and natural rubber. Full enforcement of the regulation is currently scheduled for December 30, 2025.

In December 2025, the European Parliament expressed its support for a one-year postponement of the application of the regulation. This postponement will become legally effective once the amendment is formally adopted and published in the Official Journal of the European Union.

For our standard collection of cover materials, we use 100% recycled FSC-certified paper. As fully recycled materials are excluded under the EUDR, this paper falls outside the scope of the regulation.

For clarity, some of our products may be wood-based (e.g. viscose derived from wood pulp). As of now, they do not fall within the scope of the EUDR. We continue to monitor regulatory guidance and will inform customers should any requirements become applicable.

We hope this information provides you with sufficient clarity.
